

The other serves as a restorative retreat with a fully-equipped fitness center, juice bar and spa, offering a full treatment menu and zen pool lounge. Outside, The Barn will be home to tennis courts and an active 75-foot swimming pool with a hot tub and winding water slide, all surrounded by a tranquil stream and pond, a great lawn, bocce ball court and paddle tennis pavilion..
